## **Prop 65 Compliance**

On August 30, 2016, the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment ("OEHHA") adopted various changes to the "clear and reasonable" warnings required by Proposition 65. Among other things, the new warning regulation rewrites the "safe harbor" warning label text and format, including the mandatory use of a warning symbol and reference to an official OEHHA website, and mandatory Internet and catalog point-of-sale warnings. The undersigned declares and represents that he/she is an authorized representative of *Greystone Energy Systems, Inc* and that our products **do not** contain at any level any of the chemicals currently listed on the California Proposition 65 List of Chemicals.
