### Certificate of Compliance - RoHS

The Directive on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment 2002/95/EC, commonly referred to as the Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive or RoHS 1, was adopted in February 2003 by the European Union and took effect in July 2006. This directive restricted the use of six hazardous materials in the manufacture of various types of electronic and electrical equipment. EU Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2) was adopted on January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2013 adding mercury, cadmium, lead, chromium VI, PBB and PBDE to the list of substances. Directive 2015/863/EU (RoHS3) was adopted July 22, 2019 adding four phthalates DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIPB to the list of substances
