The Opportunity

We are growing and looking for a motivated <u>Senior Buyer</u> to join the Operations team working in Moncton, New Brunswick.

Objective & Purpose

- The purpose of this role is to purchase materials and services in support of ongoing business and manufacturing operations.
- The objective of this role is to negotiate and work directly with supply chain partners to ensure the accurate and ontime delivery of products and services to support manufacturing operations; products and service that meet corporate quality standards and that are purchased at the best commercial terms/lowest prices available to the company.
- This position also provides support and input to departmental process improvement initiatives.

Principle Duties & Responsibilities

- Responsible for the planning, selection and procurement of materials as required to support ongoing business operations.
- Responsible for the daily creation, delivery, accuracy, acknowledgment, quality and on time delivery of all purchase orders, purchase order changes, request for quotations and supplier communications.
- Responsible for the negotiation, creation, maintenance, delivery, accuracy and storage of supplier pricing agreements, contracts, purchase orders etc., in accordance with corporate procedures, policies and best practices.
- Responsible to improve utilization of ERP system; drive use of ERP system as core software for business activities especially those related to procurement and material management (i.e. MRP, electronic requisitions, PO delivery, supplier order information etc.)
- Lead role in material shortage reporting and expediting processes; including participation in production daily standup meeting.
- Responsible to interface with the Finance Department to manage and resolve supplier issues as required.
- Responsible for the resolution of purchase order shortage and overages, price variances, and invoice discrepancy with suppliers.
- Responsible to process Inventory Adjustments, Cost Changes and Warehouse Transfers in SYSPRO as requested.



- Coordinate the return of obsolete inventory to supplier's for credit.
- Required to initiate and lead the ongoing reduction of on hand inventories through vendor managed inventory (VMI), JIT deliveries, and supplier partnership initiatives.
- Partner with Engineering to identify substitute materials to gain cost reductions and supply security.
- Maintain strong supplier relationships to keep informed of product developments and to ease discussions on price, service, quality and or other matters.
- Act as a resource to Engineering and Product management to investigate suppliers who are developing new technologies, materials and processes.
- Support Engineering teams by sourcing components for product development activities. Obtain quotes, procure from suppliers, follow and expedite delivery.
- Participate as active member and resource to Product Management, Engineering and the New Product Introduction (NPI) Team.
- Interact directly and regularly with Managers and Senior Managers of current and potential supplier companies; maintaining effective professional liaisons with company policies governing ethical and professional conduct.
- Evaluate market and industry trends for commodities and services; identify opportunities and recommend improvements to corporate procurement strategy.
- Monitor supplier contract to ensure ongoing compliance.
- Assist the Supply Chain Manager in the development and implementation of corporate controls, business process improvements and the continued adoption of Lean Operating principles and methodologies throughout the business.
- Assist the Supply Chain Manager in the design, development, implementation and continuous improvement of all department processes, procedures and systems to support current ISO certification.
- Assist the Supply Chain Manager in the development and delivery of comprehensive annual cost reduction programs.
- Assist the Supply Chain Manager with contract negotiations and completion of worldwide supply agreements with suppliers.
- Assist the Supply Chain and Quality Assurance Manager with new supplier identification and qualification initiatives; coordinating with Engineering, Product Management and Sales teams as needed.
- Assist the Supply Chain Manager in the maintenance and ongoing accuracy of SYSPRO (ERP system) item master information for all active SKU's (pricing, lead-time, EOQ, suppler details, etc.).
- Assist the Supply Chain Manager with the Development of our worldwide procurement and material sourcing strategy.
- Additional duties as required.

Education, Training & Experience

- Degree in Business Administration and/or CPP, SCMP Accreditation or equivalent experience.
- Minimum 8 years purchasing experience supporting manufacturing operations. Previous experience with value added assembly, metal forming and/or plastic injection would be considered an asset.
- Minimum 5 years of international supplier management, material sourcing and supplier quality assurance experience.
